

## Bathroom - Marble sink (flats 1kk, 2kk)

### MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

#### Marble

Marble is a natural stone that requires careful maintenance.

#### Cleaning

We clean only with warm, soapy water and a dry cloth.

**We never use coarse or other harsh (sand) cleaners that would they could damage the stone and thus break the protective layer that makes the marble impermeable.**

This would lead to stains and the luster of the stone could be dull and scratched.

#### Maintenance

The marble sink is treated with an impregnating layer, which should be renewed at least once a year.

#### Information and care for natural stone

- Wipe immediately after use.
- Keep the surface free of dirt.
- Do not leave the surface contaminated with any detergents, salt or water.
- Thoroughly wash and dry the surface after each wash.
- Clean the stone with a dry cloth or sponge and warm water.
- Rinse and dry with a cloth.
- If necessary, you can polish the stone surface yourself. Moisten the surface of the stone a little water and rub it with a cloth suitable for polishing the stone until the surface does not heat up. When the surface dries, it regains its shine.
- **Do not use the following on the stone:** cleaning agents containing acid, ammonia, abrasive cleaners and materials, paste-based cleaners, vinegar, alcohol, lemon, window cleaners.
- Do not polish the stone surface with harsh cleaning agents: cleaning powder, scouring pad, brushes with metal bristles, etc.
- Natural stone requires special care. Protect the surface of your sink regularly application of a protective sealing layer, we recommend at least once a year.
